The Work Session of the Clear Fork Valley Local School board was called to order at 4:30 PM by Board President Mr. Jim DeSanto.

Roll call was taken and the following members were present: Mr. Jim DeSanto, Mr. Jim Klenk, Mr. Carl Gonzalez, and Mr. Dan Freund and Mr. Jason Snyder.

INFORMATION AND PROPOSALS

The purpose of this work session was to interview architects for the Elementary Facilities project in open public forum in conjunction with the The Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC). Prior to the meeting the construction committee selected three architects to interview from a field of sixteen applicants based on the architect's statement of qualifications that were submitted.

The OCFE introduced the members of their team that were in attendance, present were Mr. Ramsey Najjir, the project administrator, Mr. Bill Prenosil, the senior planning administrator, Ms. Ann Frost, the project manager and Mr. Jon Walden, chief legal counsel for the OFCC. Ms. Sylvia Gillis, construction legal counsel for the district was also present. The three architect firms that interviewed, BSHM, Garmann Miller, and GPD presented in alphabetical order each with a 45 minute presentation followed by 15 minute question and answer session. At the conclusion of the interviews the architectural firms left. Upon completion of all the interviews the board discussed who they felt was the best fit for the district and each board member ranked the firms in the order they felt was appropriate. Mr. Gonzalez, Mr. Freund, Mr. Klenk, Mr. Snyder and Mr. DeSanto each spoke with regards to who they felt was the best fit for the district, ranking them in order. Each board member selected Garmann Miller as their first choice, followed by GPD and BSHM. Those recommendations were to be used by the construction committee to provide the OFCC with a rank score to select the architectural firm that will be hired for the project.

Mr. Jeff Sellers, 1904 Wagner Road Butler spoke up as a parent and a coach and requested that in the planning of the Butler facility the board consider the Youth League Athletic Fields and the limited amount of practice space available for the various teams.
